

Regulations of the contest „Chopin's Warsaw Piano contest“

§ 1.

General rules

1. The contest is organized by Warsaw Tourist Office, address: pl. Defilad 1, zip code 00-901, Warsaw.
2. The contest will be held between 14-16.03.2018.
3. The aim of the contest is to promote Warsaw as the city of Fryderyk Chopin.
4. The contest is not a game of chance as stated in the law from 19th November 2009 on hazard games (Dz. U. Nr 201, poz. 1540 z późn. zm.).

§ 2.

The procedure of the contest

1. The contest will be announced on Chopin's Warsaw website: [http://en.chopin.warsawtour.pl/ win-tickets-for-chopins-warsaw-piano](http://en.chopin.warsawtour.pl/win-tickets-for-chopins-warsaw-piano)
2. The task is to answer the question published on the Page mentioned in § 2, p. 1 and send the answer to the email address internet@warsawtour.pl.
3. The deadline for submitting applications expires at 23:59 on Thursday.
4. The Organizer chooses 1 winner, who receives 1 double invitation to the concert "Chopin's Warsaw Piano" which takes place in Teatr Wielki Opera Narodowa on 17.03.2018.
5. The invitation has to be collected from the staff of Fryderyk Chopin Institute on the day of the concert in Teatr Wielki Opera Narodowa
6. The Participants can be all people over 18 years old, or under 18 with the permission of parents or other legal supervisors.
7. The prizes are sponsored by the Fryderyk Chopin Institute, 43 Tamka Street, 00-355 Warsaw, Poland.
8. The Participants agree to accept the regulations and agree that their artwork/answer will be used by the Organizer of the contest digitally or in print.

§ 3.

Final rules

1. Organizers and people directly involved in the preparation of the contest cannot take part in it.
