

Regulations of the contest „Chopin and his Europe 2017“

§ 1.

General rules

1. The contest is organized by Warsaw Tourist Office, address: pl. Defilad 1, zip code 00-901, Warsaw.
2. The contest will be held between 2-16.08.2017.
3. The aim of the contest is to promote Warsaw as the city of Fryderyk Chopin.
4. The contest is not a game of chance as stated in the law from 19th November 2009 on hazard games (Dz. U. Nr 201, poz. 1540 z późn. zm.).

§ 2.

The procedure of the contest

1. The contest will be announced on Chopin's Warsaw website: <http://en.chopin.warsawtour.pl/chopin-and-his-europe-festival-2017-contest>
2. The task is to answer a question related to Fryderyk Chopin.
3. The contest is divided into 3 parts. After each part the Organizer chooses up to 10 winners, who receive 1 double invitation to a concert.
4. The participant sends the answer on the email address internet@warsawtour.pl and specifies the date of the concert from the list at the Contest website, for which he/she wishes to win a double ticket.
5. The number of invitations is limited. The Organizer will process the applications in the chronological order.
6. The dates when each part ends and the winners are announced: 9.08.2017 (part 1), 11.08.2017 (part 2), 16.08.2017 (part 3)
7. The deadline for submitting applications is at 23:59 on the day preceding the end of each part.
8. The Prize has to be collected until 15:00 on the day of the concert from the Tourist Information Point (<http://warsawtour.pl/en/warsaw-essentials/tourist-information/warsaw-tourist-information-1809.html>)
9. The contesters can be all people over 18 years old, or under 18, with the permission of parents or other legal supervisors.
10. The prizes are sponsored by the Fryderyk Chopin Institute, 43 Tamka Street, 00-355 Warsaw, Poland.
11. The Participants agree to accept the regulations and agree that their artwork/answer will be used by the Organizer of the contest digitally or in print.

§ 3.

Final rules

1. Organizers and people directly involved in the preparation of the contest cannot take part in it.

3. The organizers do not hold responsibility for any damage suffered by participants in relation to the contest or connected with using the prize.
4. The organizers can change the existing Regulation on condition that it does not violate the rights of the contesters.
